The Scholarship Ministry

1. OVERVIEW

The Mount Charity Baptist Church has implemented a scholarship program for its active, financial members. A scholarship ministry committee, appointed by the Pastor, administers the program.

2. DUTIES OF THE MINISTRY

- A. To set up guidelines governing the scholarship program.
- B. To annually publicize the scholarship program.
- C. To periodically evaluate the scholarship program.
- D. To distribute and collect completed applications.
- E. To design instruments for evaluating applicants in an objective manner.

3. FINANCING OF THE PROGRAM

The Mount Charity Baptist Church Scholarship Ministry is generated annually with contributions from the church, congratulatory ads, donations, etc.

4. GUIDELINES FOR ELIGIBILITY AND AWARDS

- 1. Applicant must be a member of Mount Charity Baptist Church for at least six months at the time of application.
- 2. Applicant must attend/have attended Christian education classes (Sunday School, Bible Study, Youth Ministry).
- 3. Applicant must be a high school graduate or GED recipient.
- 4. Applicant must be 17 to 25 years of age at the time of application.
- 5. Applicant must be enrolled in a university, community college or trade school as a **FULL-TIME** student according to their school's standards.
- 6. Applicant must use funds for undergraduate studies/trade school.
- 7. Applicant must submit ALL required documentation:
 - · completed application
 - copy of high school diploma
 - verification that he/she is enrolled in school (submit one)
 - admissions letter
 - copy of class schedule for the semester
 - signed acknowledgement letter.
- 8. Scholarship recipient must remain in a school of higher learning for the entire quarter, semester and/or school year.
- 9. Scholarship recipient is responsible for notifying MCBC immediately if changes affecting information in the application occur prior to the beginning of the academic year.

- 10. Scholarship recipient is eligible to reapply yearly; but will only be eligible for four consecutive years of undergraduate studies.
- 11. Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the awardee. Funds will not be dispersed until verification of enrollment has been received.
- 12. Scholarship monies to high school graduates and college students will be presented once a year.

5. AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

- A. HIGH SCHOOL: High school graduates entering college for the first time will receive \$500 if attending an accredited four-year college/university or \$250 if attending a vocational or community college. Students attending non-accredited schools will receive half (1/2) of the above amount.
- B. UNDERGRADUATES STUDENTS: See undergraduate/trade student form.

It is the responsibility of each student to submit an application for scholarship.
